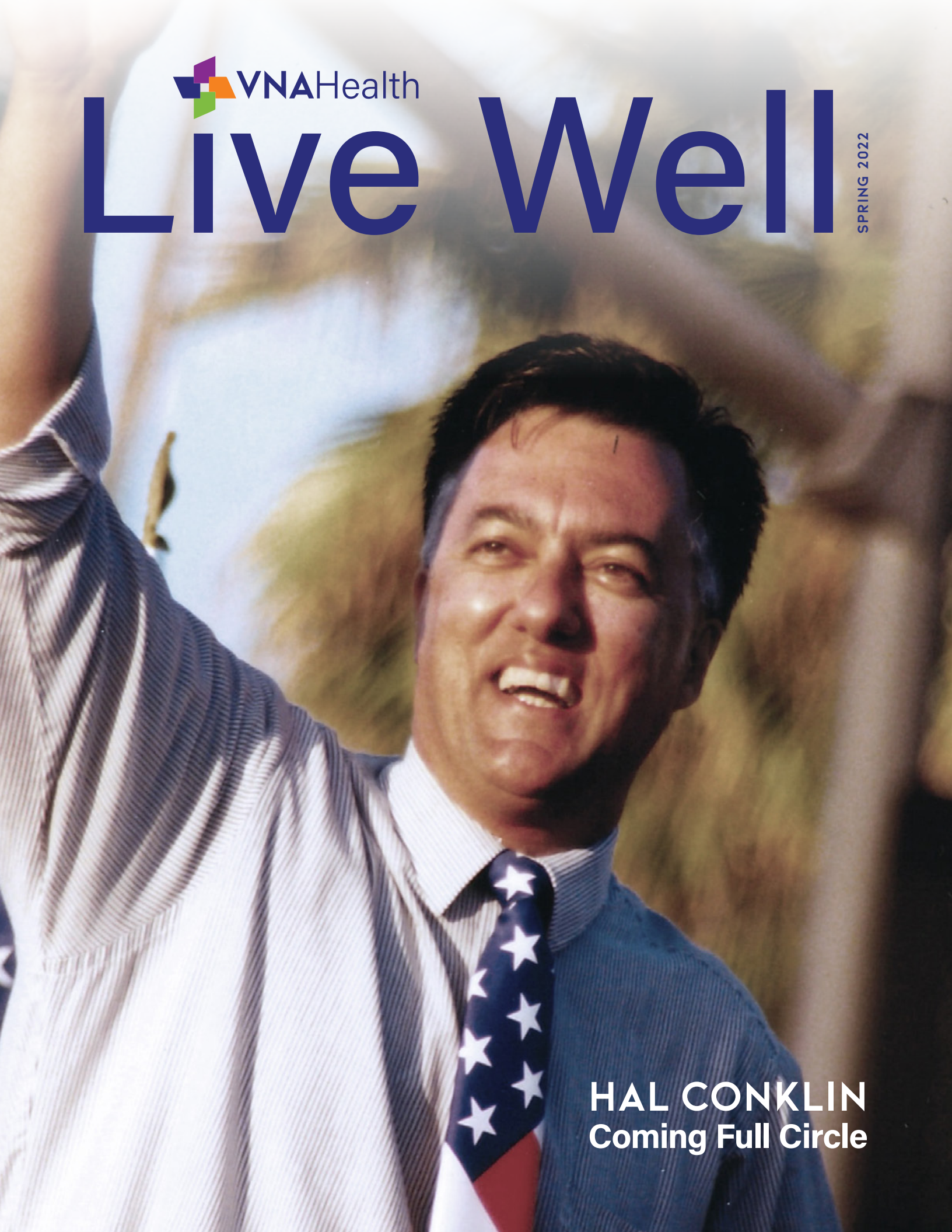

Coming Full Circle

“Guess where I am?” Hal said, with that familiar endearing chuckle of his. “I’m at the Serenity House. I’ve come full circle.”

HAL CONKLIN — former Santa Barbara mayor, councilmember, environmental pioneer, arts advocate, and civic visionary — died from brain cancer complications in May 2021 at VNA Health’s Serenity House. Hal came full circle to Serenity House which is built on the former site of the Community Environmental Council’s (CEC) headquarters where he had served as co-director.

Hal was a man on a mission, a true community hero for over 50 years. While he was a leading advocate for environmental protection, Hal was also passionate about the arts, historic preservation, community planning and development, and city governance. Some of his noteworthy accomplishments include: launching California’s first recycling program (originally at the corner of Garden and Ortega); leading the charge to save Stearns Wharf after it was demolished in a fire; leading the upgrade of Santa Barbara’s train station; advocating for commercial

development restrictions to protect housing supply; backing needed upgrades to the Lobero and Granada theatres; protecting the Santa Barbara waterfront from massive development resulting in the expansion of Chase Palm Park; championing downtown revitalization efforts giving rise to Paseo Nuevo and new parking lots that have served the area for the past 30 years; dedicating 17 years to civil service as city councilmember and later esteemed mayor; and founding Common Table Foundation to unite the entire community through shared events after the Thomas Fire and debris flow.

In September 2020, Hal underwent emergency brain surgery after suddenly collapsing — and he did not wake from the ordeal for three weeks. He received excellent care at Cottage Hospital and Cottage Rehabilitation Hospital.

Hal lived five months longer than what the doctors believed, according to Hal's wife, Haley McGuire Conklin. "I said to Dr. [Frederic] Kass, 'Thank you so much for giving us this time with him.' "And he said, 'It wasn't me. It was Hal's faith and belief.'"

In May 2021, Haley said to Hal, "You know, Dr. Kass feels it's time for you to be at Serenity House where they can monitor you and give you whatever you need." And Hal said, 'You know, honey, the last few days I've been feeling a shift. Yes, it's time.' Before we left the house, Hal just stood there, taking one more look around the house before he left. That was really tough."

Hal was at Serenity House on the night of the Loma fire, which threatened the entire Mesa. Within hours of receiving the mandatory evacuation orders, all Serenity House patients had been safely moved to other trusted care facilities in the community. But Hal was the last one to go, as he was transitioning (a term signaling that death is imminent).

"We're all standing around Hal, praying and listening to his gospel music and I'm thinking, 'He's going to leave us any minute,'" shared Haley. "All of a sudden the doors to his suite open up and the staff say, 'We've got to go now. Everybody has left Serenity House. We've got to get you out.'"

We all rushed down to the parking lot and we were waiting near the ambulance where they loaded Hal. Two of his sons rode in the ambulance with him and they took us to the Samarkand facility. The nurses that came with us from Serenity House were amazing and took really good care of him."

Late the next morning, Hal was moved back to Serenity House. "The wonderful staff at Serenity House told his sons, 'Tell us some stories about your childhood,'" shared Haley. "Well, there was always humor in the Conklin household. So they started to tell the stories and we were all laughing. Within an hour of being back at Serenity House, the nurse said, 'It's happening'...and we saw him just leave."

Haley said, "He transitioned in Hal Conklin time, because he never did anything a moment before he was ready. I always used to say that about him. If he wanted to go from Serenity House, then he wasn't leaving from any other place. It was only fitting that he would leave from Serenity House. I mean, there wasn't a part of this town that Hal, hadn't touched. That's the only way I could describe it."

Reminiscing, Haley shared, "I haven't been back there to Serenity House, but when I drive the freeway every day I look up and I say a little prayer of gratitude for that place and it makes me smile as I think, 'Well, you chose the perfect place to leave from.'"

Hal Conklin died at Serenity House on Friday, May 21, 2021, at the age of 75.

REFLECTIONS FROM HAL CONKLIN'S FAMILY AND FRIENDS

“You would think we’d known each other forever, within an hour or so of meeting each other. He was just the easiest human being to connect with on any level. He lit up a room and he knew everybody and cared about everybody. What I learned very quickly was, don't send him to the supermarket to pick up a few things because he could be gone for hours! I would say he had the biggest heart of anyone I've ever known. Just an incredible, wonderful man. ”

“It was just five days before Hal died. He called me. ‘Guess where I am?’ he said, with that familiar endearing chuckle of his. ‘I’m at the Serenity House. I’ve come full circle.’ The significance of Hal being at Serenity House, the beautiful hospice facility on the Mesa overlooking Santa Barbara, can’t be overstated. Serenity House was built at the site of the Community Environmental Council’s (CEC) headquarters, and a portion of that original CEC building is incorporated into the Serenity House complex as it stands today. Hal and I were CEC’s co-directors back in 1970, the year CEC was founded by a community galvanized by Santa Barbara’s momentous 1969 oil spill. Hal told me that he was about to exit this life from a place and an organization that was, in many respects, his birthplace in Santa Barbara. His call was a poignant one. I sensed it could be our last conversation. Sadly, it was.”

ABOUT SERENITY HOUSE

Serenity House is Santa Barbara’s treasured hospice home. Owned and operated by VNA Health, it provides a unique care option for hospice patients whose needs cannot be managed successfully at home. Located on the Mesa overlooking beautiful Santa Barbara, it has 18 private rooms to provide families and friends the opportunity to spend time with their loved ones in a tranquil setting away from the demands of home. Guests can gather in the family room, take walks on the scenic paths, and be with their loved one even overnight. It is the only facility of its kind within 150 miles (and one of 14 licensed in California).

The Serenity House staff focus on quality of life for patients and their families through medical, emotional, and spiritual support. The hospice team includes physicians, registered and licensed vocational nurses, certified aides, medical social workers, spiritual and bereavement counselors, chaplains, certified music therapists, pet therapists, integrative therapy aides, a registered dietician, a chef, and hospice-trained volunteers. Staff and volunteers are at the heart of Serenity House – what they do goes far beyond their professional skills and licenses — it is a sacred calling.

Everyone, including those without adequate financial resources or insurance, has access to a peaceful and dignified passing at Serenity House. VNA Health is the only home healthcare provider committed to Santa Barbara families through a charitable mission. This mission ensures that no one is turned away due to financial hardship (nearly 30% of all Serenity House patients receive financial assistance). Without Serenity House, many families would have few, if any, options for quality and compassionate end-of-life care for their loved ones. VNA Health is grateful to maintain this vital resource through the generosity of the Santa Barbara community.

Finding Your Way

SUSANNA AND TONY'S STORY

Tony and Susanna each lost their beloved spouses after long and fruitful marriages. At different times, they each sought support from Bereavement Care. After meeting Susanna, Bereavement Counselor Dairine Pearson suggested she might benefit from the Writing to Heal group. Dairine had an intuition it would suit Susanna's desire to explore her experience in a creative manner. In this group, Tony and Susanna met. Slowly, their friendship deepened into love. After two years of working through love and grief, they joyfully married on Valentine's Day. Tony later experienced a resurgence of cancer that had long been in remission. His condition was treated, but he eventually required hospice care. Susanna lovingly cared for Tony at home and then later at Serenity House, where he died with grace and peace. Susanna is a beautiful example of resilience in grief.

"I remember walking into the Writing to Heal class and thinking, "I don't sleep, I don't eat, I don't think I have the energy to do this." But Dairine, in her magical way, slowly brought the color of life back to our ashen cheeks. Tony and I were each grappling with the loss of our amazing spouses, two giant hearts of compassion. I will be eternally grateful for the healing we each experienced, the connection with writing that brought us back to our whole selves, and for

the time we had together — too brief and yet deep beyond measure." — SUSANNA

TERESA'S STORY

Teresa cared for her father before he died on hospice care at VNA Health's Serenity House. In this same season, she also lost two brothers: Mark died quickly from illness soon before her father's passing, and Jerry died unexpectedly six months after her father. These multiple losses were a tremendous strain - physically, emotionally, and mentally. Added to it all, her dog Kiley was diagnosed with a terminal illness. Over time, Teresa began to heal from her loss by working with her Bereavement Counselor Mara Petrick; attending Mindfulness in Grief and Healing through Collage groups; and doing relaxing activities such as gentle exercise, journaling, and other creative outlets.

"I will always remember my earth angel Mara who helped me during my darkest days. I feel like you helped me when I most needed to be lifted, held, and heard. Your gentle, loving, mindful presence held me together during those beginning weeks/months. I am so grateful to have had this time, not rushed, to help me process this strenuous journey of grief and stress. Having a safe place to come together and talk as much as I wanted or needed about my grief and

WHAT IS GRIEF?

Perhaps grief is very familiar to you, an echo of all the losses you've encountered in life. Perhaps grief is new and shocking, hitting way harder than you expected. There are many stories of grief.

- + You've lost the love of your life, your rock, your anchor, and you've never lived alone before

- + You've lost someone with whom you had a difficult relationship, and now don't know what to feel
- + You've lost someone slowly, over years of illness
- + You lost someone suddenly and without warning
- + You've lost who you are; you feel alone and shut out from others
- + You never knew grief would feel like this
- + You wonder if meeting others going through grief would help, or not

We understand. We get it. VNA Health's Bereavement Care trained counselors offer individual, couples, family, and group counseling to help you through the grief process. Our care is available to anyone in Santa Barbara County and is free of charge. It is offered in both English and Spanish. A counselor can meet with you to determine what kind of support best suits you, and help you find your way at a difficult time.

VNA Health currently offers individual and group grief counseling in person and via telehealth. Services are offered in full compliance with COVID-19 safety precautions. 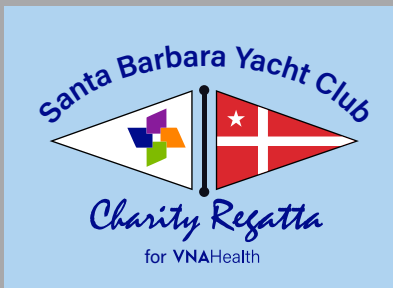

President & CEO Lynda Tanner Retires after 14 Years on Valentine's Day



AFTER 14 YEARS OF DEDICATED SERVICE

Lynda Tanner, RN, MSN retired from VNA Health as President and Chief Executive Officer (CEO) on Valentine's Day 2022. Lynda started in 2008 as Chief Operations Officer (COO) when VNA Health was known as Visiting Nurse & Hospice Care. In 2010, Lynda became the agency's President & CEO, serving for the next 12 years. Under Lynda's leadership, VNA Health grew from a small community home care agency into an award-winning, nationally recognized, regional healthcare leader providing comprehensive in-home healthcare, including home health, palliative, hospice, and bereavement care.

As CEO, Lynda immediately oversaw one of the organization's most significant projects — the construction and opening of the 18-bed Serenity House — the only Medicare licensed in-patient hospice facility in Santa Barbara County. In 2011, Serenity House opened on the Mesa. At the time, however, legislative restrictions meant only 12 of the 18 beds could be used; so Lynda pressed for legislative change, ultimately resulting in the passage of SB 177.

Sponsored by former State Senator Tony Strickland and former Assemblyman Das Williams, SB 177 was a special statute for Santa Barbara County, extending the number of patient beds in "congregate living health facilities" to a maximum of 25 beds for serving people who are terminally ill. Signed into law in 2012 by Governor Brown, SB 177 gave Serenity House the ability to utilize all 18 beds and meet the needs of our community. More than a decade later, Serenity

House continues to provide a home away from home for patients facing end of life, and in support of their loved ones.

Also in 2011, Lynda directed the acquisition of Community Home Health, increasing VNA Health's delivery of home health services by 35%. To further serve the communities of the Lompoc, Santa Ynez, and Santa Maria Valleys, Lynda successfully obtained branch status for a satellite location in Solvang in 2012. Later that year, Lynda oversaw the move of the organization's corporate office to its current location in downtown Santa Barbara.

With the evolving dynamics of healthcare, VNA Health recognized the vital role that community education plays in achieving and maintaining health. In 2014, Lynda led the development of VNA Health's PHorum: Perspectives in Healthcare, which has become Santa Barbara's premier annual healthcare symposium for national, regional, and local healthcare leaders to share and discuss relevant issues impacting our community. Through the years, PHorum speakers have discussed the Affordable Care Act, the collaboration of nonprofits to provide greater access to affordable healthcare, the power of choosing what's most important when facing end of life, and the healing and empowering nature of music for both patients and families living with loss or caring for a loved one with Alzheimer's. In 2018, Lynda accepted the prestigious national award for PHorum, as the ElevatingHOME Program of the Year from the national organization Visiting Nurses Associations of America.

The 2022 PHorum was Lynda's ninth, and in honor of her leadership and service, VNA Health established the Lynda Tanner Tribute where all funds donated support VNA Health's ongoing community education programs, such as the annual PHorum.

Another important and vital community care program is We Honor Veterans, a program of the National Hospice and Palliative Care Organization in collaboration with the Department of Veterans Affairs. In November 2017, after five years of diligent work, Lynda announced that VNA Health achieved Level 4 of the We Honor Veterans program. To this day, VNA Health is the only nonprofit hospice organization in the Tri-County area (Santa Barbara, Ventura, and San Luis Obispo) to have achieved this level.

One month later, Lynda led the agency to earn The Joint Commission's Gold Seal of Approval® for Home Care Accreditation for home health and hospice care by demonstrating continuous compliance with its performance standards. The Joint Commission is an independent, not-for-profit organization that accredits U.S. healthcare organizations. The Gold Seal of Approval® is a symbol of quality that reflects an organization's commitment to providing safe and effective care.

Again in 2020, Lynda led VNA Health to receive reaccreditation for home health care and hospice care, and accreditation for palliative care. As healthcare in the home becomes the preferred choice, it is important that home care providers are able to demonstrate that they are capable of providing safe, high quality care.

An important milestone in Lynda's career was rebranding the organization. VNA Health was founded in 1908 as the Visiting Nurse Association of Santa Barbara, the third oldest VNA in California. In 2001, the organization changed its name to Visiting Nurse & Hospice Care to reflect the addition of its Medicare-certified medical hospice program. In 2016, Lynda and the Board of Directors initiated a strategic phased rebranding plan. After extensive quantitative and qualitative market research, and unanimous support from the Board, Lynda announced the organization's new brand on September 19, 2019.

Changing the organization's name to VNA Health and its tagline to "Live Well" reflects the organization's ongoing commitment to providing quality health care and its promise to help the communities it serves to live well. Just prior to the launch of the new brand, Lynda was asked in an interview: "What does it mean to live well?" Lynda softly smiled and replied:

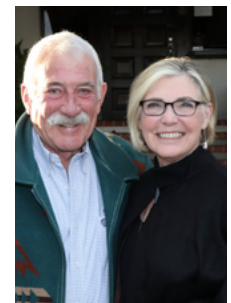
